

The Townsend Military Band will conclude its 2019 Thursday evening concert series on the Townsend Common on August 29th. Townsend Fire/EMS personnel will be selling hot dogs, hamburgers, cheeseburgers, bacon cheeseburgers, and sausages with peppers and onions to hungry concertgoers to benefit the Townsend Fire/EMS Relief Association. They will also offer cold soda and bottled water for sale.

Hildreth's arrangement of the "Our Director March" and Brown's arrangement of "Singing In The Rain" will be played following intermission. Brown's arrangement of "Highlights from Jersey Boys" and Sousa's "Stars and Stripes Forever" will be performed before the Townsend Military Band concludes its concert at 9:30 by playing the "Star Spangled Banner."
