Nashoba Associated Boards of Health is pleased to offer several upcoming COVID-19 vaccine clinics! We will be providing Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine for eligible\* members of our community who are 12+ years of age.

Eligible\* community members must either be completing their primary Pfizer series OR have had their final Pfizer vaccine in the 2-dose series at least 5 months prior to a booster, final Moderna vaccine in the 2-dose series 6 months prior to a booster, OR their single dose J&J vaccine at least 2 months prior to getting a booster shot.

- What: Pfizer (12+) COVID-19 vaccine for primary series or booster dose.
- When: Wednesdays in February- 2/2/22, 2/9/22, 2/16/22, and 2/23/22, 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM
- Where: St. Anthony Church Hall, 33 Chapel St Shirley MA 01464
- \*Eligibility requirements: People 12 and older can receive Pfizer vaccine for their primary series doses OR as a booster.
