TEMPORARY SIGNS AND SANDWICH BOARDS
LOCATION POLICY FOR 276 MAIN STREET

POLICY #01-10

The Town's sign by-law (145-62.A(8)), authorizes temporary, unlighted signs. The Selectmen's Office approves temporary signs advertising events promoted or sponsored by Town agencies or non-profit organizations operating in or serving Townsend.

The following conditions shall apply to all temporary signs and sandwich boards:

1. Maximum one (1) free standing sign or sandwich board per organization per event.
2. Maximum size: 36" wide X 36" tall, including legs.
3. No Day-Glo poster board or fluorescent background.
4. The sign may be placed no earlier than 7 days before the event and shall be removed within 24 hours of the end of the event. Failure to timely remove may result in the organization not receiving permission for a sign in the future.
5. Signs shall be placed on the front lawn of the Hart Library and shall be set back a minimum 12 feet from the face of the stone wall.
6. Permits for no more than 2 events shall be granted at a time.
