### WATER COMMISSIONERS MEETING AGENDA February 13, 2023 - 7:00 P.M.

On July 16, 2022, Governor Baker signed into law An Act Relative to Extending Certain State of Emergency Accommodations, which, among other things, extends the expiration of the provisions pertaining to the Open Meeting Law to March 31, 2023. Specifically, this extension allows public bodies to continue holding meetings remotely without a quorum of the public body physically present at a meeting location, and to provide "adequate, alternative" access to remote meetings. The Act does not make any new changes to the Open Meeting Law other than extending the expiration date of the temporary provisions regarding remote meetings from July 15, 2022, to March 31, 2023.

- 7:30 Siaw Emma, 4 Bayberry Hill Road. RE: Bill Adjustment. Mr. Siaw reported that he conducted some research on water lines and realized he could have a leak coming from the sprinkler system. He reported he received a notification from the Water Department informing him of a leak. He called a friend to take a look, but the line was manually shut down until next summer and cannot be fixed until then. TM stated per notes after the November 2022 meeting there was a leak for 7 days, but that we do not have information pertaining to the possible leak during the summer. TM asked to see proof in writing for the leak from a plumber or irrigation company and a promise it will be fixed in the summer. TM motioned to abate the 2022 3rd quarter water bill to tier 1 usage rates and the resident is to pay the balance, and the abated amount is to be held as a credit on the account until written proof is

5.1 CSD reported he received a number of complaints concerning the flushing at Deluxe. A notice was posted for residents on Facebook as well as on the town website. TM said the problem facing Timberlee Park is the dead-end streets with no hydrants available to flush the system.

Discussed the Board of Health agenda for tomorrow concerning water, TM will write a letter explaining the water is safe. TM suggested to start a project next year to add hydrants on dead-end streets, DV stated it is in process.

### VI. SUPERINTENDENT'S UPDATES AND REPORTS-VOTES MAY BE TAKEN:

- 6.1 Update/Discuss PFAS/Harbor Trace Treatment Plant. DV reported we received the last permit for storm water from the planning board, and the DEP permit last Friday. Bids are due back on March 31st for the water lines, and April 7th for the treatment plant. TM asked about Capital Planning and if they agreed, DV said yes.
  - CSD asked if there will be a groundbreaking. TM would like to, NM agreed as long as we don't spend extra money.
- 6.2 Update/Discuss Warrant Articles. DV excess money for what the treatment plant needs. DV also mentioned that TM and NM need to sign generator contract. TM also thanked the town for the funding to purchase the generators.
